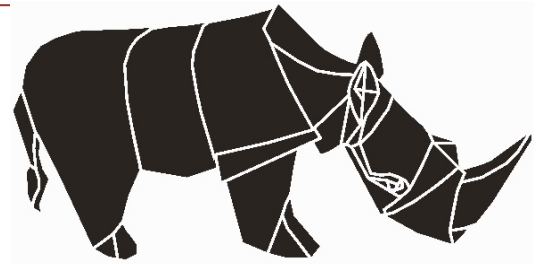
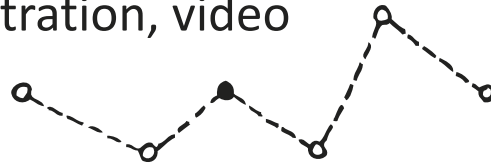


Case Study: Paper Rhino

An example of a more recently established workers' co-operative is Paper Rhino, the Peterborough-based specialist in graphic design, illustration, video and typography.



Paper Rhino operates on a flat structure, with shared profits and an equal say in all decisions.

Started by two freelancers and incorporated in 2014, the co-operative now has 6 members, and a 6-figure turnover.

The co-operative offers an alternate way for its creative members to enjoy the benefits of being self-employed, whilst minimising the risks associated with this such as irregular work.
